- With the Office of the Aging no longer using the Town Hall, the monthly water testing fall back on the Town. Cammie has completed the permit and has named the hall "Town of Coventry Community Center" that is to be submitted to County Environmental Health Department, and Cammie will take the samples and deliver monthly on days when she attends county meeting. The Town will be billed accordingly. The Events committee wanted to have public participating into the name of the facility and can still do this. The name can simply be changed at any time.
- The draft official report from the State Audit on Transparency has been received by Cammie and the members of the Town Board. Some of the items have been changed and implemented already, corrections need to be submitted within 90 days of receipt, Correctios will be done and submitted to the Board for the March meeting approval.
- George made a motion to approve entering into a service contract with Air Temp Heating and Air Conditioning, Inc. for the Boiler at the Town Hall and the Propane heating system in one Garage of the Highway dept. at a cost of \$1,788.00 per year. Greg seconded the motion. All are in favor.
- Greg made a motion to approve installation of a new Oil Burning Furnace for the Highway Garage in the amount of \$14,237.00. George seconded the motion. Roll Call: Greg, yes; Bob, yes; George, yes; Randy, yes and Cammie, yes.
